

APPLICATION (DUE by 5 p.m. Friday, November 18, 2016)

Applicants submit a packet to the University Teaching & Learning Commons for consideration. The entire application should be prefaced by the attached cover sheet. To present a convincing case of excellent teaching, the committee requires evidence from the following:

1. Please provide a CV
2. Provide copies of the two most recent peer evaluation of teaching
3. A summary of teaching accomplishments (not more than 12 pages, in 10-point type or larger):
 - a) Courses taught with enrollments
 - b) Teaching-related publications and/or presentations
 - c) Teaching awards
 - d) Teaching grants
 - e) Course development
 - f) Teaching innovations/curriculum design
 - g) Teaching-related service
 - h) A reflective statement of the applicant's teaching philosophy and self-analysis
 - i) An explanation of three specific courses that reflect applicant's teaching philosophy
 - j) A SUMMARY of student evaluations and comments from the past three years

In addition, the applicant may include the following optional materials (while still observing the 12-page limit):

- k) Attendance at workshops, seminars, or conferences related to teaching
 - l) Information on the extent of student learning
 - m) Evidence of teaching rigor
 - n) Student work samples
 - o) Any additional information related to teaching
4. A recent photo graph (head shot)
5. No more than four (4) support letters from colleagues, and former students
6. A letter of recommendation from applicant's department chair

Applications must be submitted in PDF form to the UTLC no later than **5pm on Friday, November 18, 2016**. Applicants may send an email with attachments to teach_xl@uncg.edu
