Online Learning

We offer an online series of courses to provide faculty members with on-going support and feedback throughout the development and/or re-development of an online course at UNCG.

Level One

If you are new to online learning, this is the best place to start. Using the student learning outcomes for the course, participants develop summative and formative assessments, explore a variety of course formats, search for and develop new online resources, decide the best engagement strategies to use and prepare students for their online course. If you need to develop an online course for the near future, use this course to help you meet your goals and get feedback along the way.

Level Two

If you have taught online before but you are ready to explore new approaches and strategies, Level Two is your starting place. Participants review the latest research about what works in online environments, learn new ways for students to collaborate online, create new resources with media tools, explore new ways to facilitate and create assessments and experience a variety of communication tools from the viewpoint of a student.

How it works Both levels are 8 weeks in length taught online via Canvas. Participants should plan to spend at least 2-3 hours each week reviewing the content and creating in either their development site or present-day online course in Canvas. Through discussions and assignments, participants receive weekly feedback about their specific course.
